REQUIREMENTS

Four bottles of each wine per class are required. Two bottles are used for the judging (one is a back up), and the remainder for the tasting at the Awards Presentation and Wine Tasting Evening. As the Chamber is a non-profit organisation with a limited funding base, a participation fee is charged. This fee helps the Chamber cover the administrative costs associated with organising the Concours and entitles each participating vineyard to 2 complimentary tickets to the Awards Presentation and Wine Tasting Event, which includes a degustation of French cheese and charcuterie.

Vineyards wishing to participate should confirm their entries by faxing or mailing the Entry Form, Vineyard Details and Payment Details to the French Chamber by no later than **THURSDAY 9 NOVEMBER 2008**.

Each judge scores individually and then scores are compiled using the 20-point international system.

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded in each class.
